

Honfleur Gallery and Vivid Solutions Gallery Call for Artist Proposals, October 2016

Honfleur Gallery and Vivid Solutions Gallery are seeking proposals from independent artists and curators for 2017-2018. Each gallery keeps a schedule of six shows per year, with each show lasting between six to eight weeks.

Honfleur Gallery is a contemporary fine art space located in the Historic Anacostia neighborhood of Washington DC at 1241 Good Hope Road SE, WDC. The gallery opened in 2007 and maintains a rigorous schedule of exhibitions and programming that focuses on cutting edge exhibitions by local, national, and international living artists. The street level gallery display area is approximately 1,000 square feet, with 10'6" ceilings. There is approximately 135 linear feet of wall available for displays.

Vivid Solutions Gallery is a photography and digital exhibition space that is dedicated to showcasing and supporting established contemporary artists as well as aspiring local talents. Photographers associated with Vivid range in documentary, fine art & portraiture photography. The gallery is located inside of the Anacostia Arts Center and is about 500 sq. ft.

Honfleur and Vivid are dedicated and pursuant of art exhibitions that have a socially charged thematic basis often used as a platform for dialogue. Experimental media and installation works are welcome in the gallery, alongside more traditional art media. Exhibitions range between thematic exhibitions, group shows, solo exhibitions, experimental projects, and artist collaborations. Implementing a diversity of projects is a consistent goal.

Applicants should hold an understanding of how gallery exhibitions come together. Gallery staff experienced in all aspects of exhibition production will support and work with artists and curators as it best benefits both parties. It is recommended that you visit the gallery before submitting your proposal.

How to Apply

To apply, please submit a portfolio to arts@archdc.org that includes the following:

- Current resume/CV
- 10-20 JPEG images of works proposed for the exhibition
- Artist/Curatorial statement
- Short bio

- Support information (URL of artist's website or social media, articles, reviews, related press, past projects, etc)

If submitting as a curator please also include:

- List of proposed artists, with work samples
 - Indicate if work samples are works to be included in the exhibition OR if they are representative of new work that will be produced for the exhibition
- Estimated production budget
 - Honfleur Gallery will coordinate marketing and advertising, do not calculate those related costs
- Any additional material that may be helpful in understanding your proposed project
