



Honfleur Gallery Call for 2018 Exhibition Proposals

Due: May 1, 2017

Honfleur Gallery is seeking proposals from independent artists and curators for our 2018 season. The gallery keeps a schedule of six shows per year, with each show lasting between six to eight weeks.

Honfleur Gallery is a contemporary fine art space located in the Historic Anacostia neighborhood of Washington, DC at 1241 Good Hope Road SE. The gallery opened in 2007 and maintains a rigorous schedule of exhibitions and programming that focuses on cutting edge work by local, national, and international living artists. The street level gallery display area is approximately 1,000 square feet, with 10'6" ceilings. There is approximately 135 linear feet of wall available for displays.

Honfleur is dedicated and pursuant of art exhibitions that engage in current social, political, and/or artistic discourse. Experimental media and installation works are welcome in the gallery, alongside more traditional art media. Implementing a diversity of projects is a consistent goal.

Gallery staff will support and work with artists and curators as it best benefits both parties. It is recommended that all involved artists or curators visit the gallery before submitting your proposal.

Honfleur Gallery is a project of ARCH, a nonprofit committed to Anacostia since 1986.

How to Apply

Please submit a portfolio to arts@archdc.org by May 1, 2017 that includes the following:

- 5-20 JPEG images and/or videos (3 minutes or less in duration) of relevant work
 - Indicate if work will be included in the exhibition, or if images are representative of new work that has yet to be produced
 - Label with artist's name and title of the work (e.g. FredDouglass_Untitled1.jpeg)
 - Optional: Include dimensions, materials, year completed, and other pertinent information in a separate document
- Artist/Curatorial statement
- Exhibition Description
- Current resume/CV
- Short bio
- Proposal for at least one related program (panel discussion, artist talk, workshop) costing \$100 or less to execute
- Support information (URL of artist's website or social media, articles, reviews, related press, past projects, etc.)
- If submitting as a curator, please also include a list of proposed artists with labeled work samples.
